Ancient Forest / Chun T'oh Whudujut Park and Protected Area & Slim Creek Park

BC Parks is developing a management plan that will follow a multi-stage process:



Initial Planning: An initial planning phase will be conducted for the management planning process in the winter of 2019. The Project Plan will be posted on the BC Parks website - bcparks.ca/planning - on *February 8th*, 2019 with an opportunity to submit initial input on a series of questions. The two parks and protected area are within the Lheidli T'enneh Nation traditional territory and are an area of cultural, ecological and environmental importance. The management plan will be developed collaboratively by Lheidli T'enneh and BC Parks.

Draft Management Plan: During this stage, the planning team will identified the values, vision (the desired future condition) and principles that will guide future management of the park. Previously identified interests and issues will be discussed, and appropriate management direction developed in the form of a vision, management objectives and strategies, and a zoning plan. As per the BC Parks policy, there will be an opportunity for public review and comment on the draft plan. Stay tuned for a public open house in later in 2019.

It is anticipated that a **Final Management Plan** will be completed and approved by the spring of 2020.
